Plate Collection

This week's plate collection will help Burundian Unitarian refugees living in Kigali, Rwanda, to meet their basic needs. We hold a special relationship with members of the Burundi Unitarian Church since 2014 when we exchanged visits. The church is still functioning despite the civil unrest that plagues Burundi; unfortunately, many members have had to flee the country for their safety. A small group is living together in exile, supporting each other as they seek a better life. They need approximately \$700 per month, and their only source of support is the greater UU community. Checks should be made out to UUSWH and include "Burundi" on the memo line.


