## **Plate Collection**

Our monthly plate collection theme for December is **Housing and Poverty** and this Sunday's collection will allow us to maintain our long-standing commitment of providing a monthly meal of American chop-suey, bread, and salad to **Bristol Lodge in Waltham**. Bristol Lodge serves a population of homeless or otherwise disadvantaged men and women. They remain in pandemic mode--no longer serving sit-down meals, but packaging them for take-out. During the pandemic, we could only send them monthly checks, but with kitchen access since September, we have resumed meal preparation which has been very much appreciated. Our dinners have always been a favorite for the clientele. Your generosity has been and will continue to be vital to continuing this effort!

#### Touchstones


